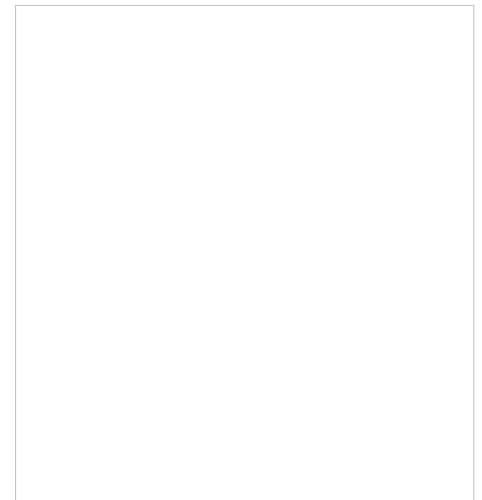
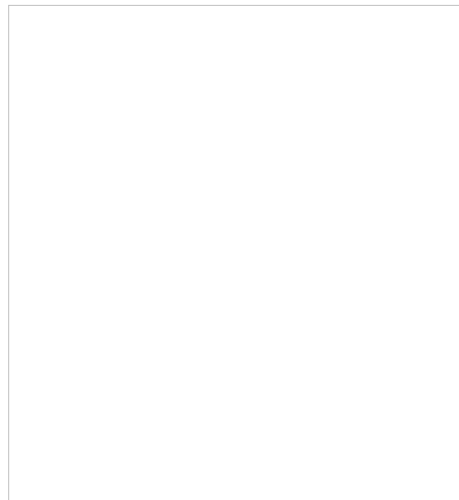

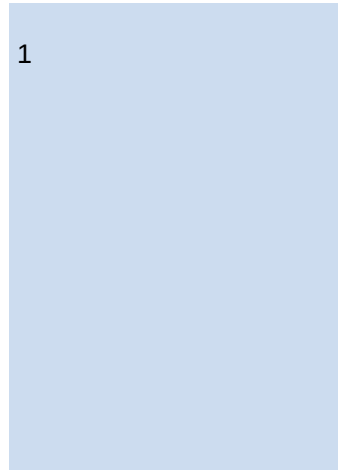
New HSE Training

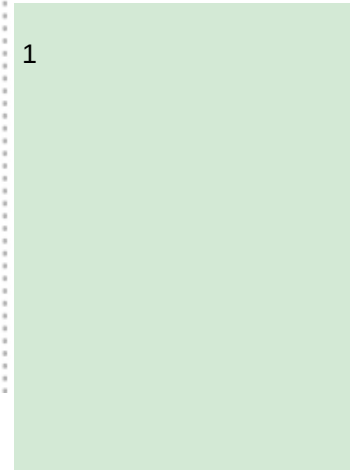
