Reporting a near miss could save a life, it might be yours!

Important News



PDO aims to maintain a safe and healthy environment working by correcting situations that caused or could likely cause injury or damage. When an incident occurs, it is important to report the occurrence so corrective actions could be taken to make sure that a similar or more serious incidents do not re-occur. An incident is defined as "an unplanned and undesired event or chain of events that have, or could have, resulted in injury or illness, damage to assets, environment, reputation, and/or company consequential business loss". There are different types of reportable incidents:





HSE Advice

A near miss incident is an incident that could have caused illness, injury or damage to assets, the environment or company reputation, or consequential business loss, but did not. It is an unplanned event that did not result in an injury, illness, or damage to assets, environment or Company reputation, but had the potential to do so if some circumstance of the event were different. Only a fortunate break in the chain of events prevented an injury, fatality or damage; in other words, a miss that was nonetheless very near.
